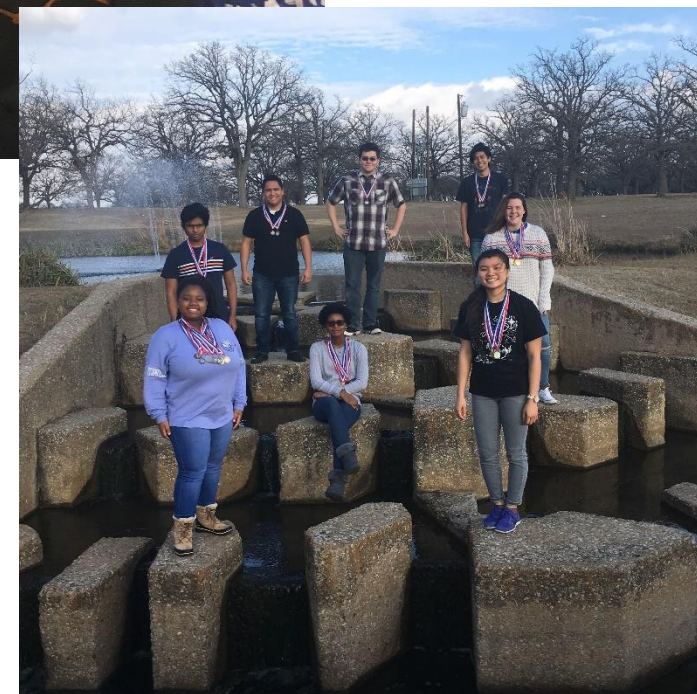

3. What are the school hours?

School hours for 2017-18 are 9:05am – 4:15pm. We are on an A-day / B-day block schedule, meaning students will take four 95-minute classes on A-days and four different 95-minute classes on B-days. A-days and B-days rotate back and forth.

4. How does bus transportation work at TAG?
