All students should turn in a copy of their final 8th grade report card to the TAG office by June 14. Students who attended 8th grade outside of Dallas ISD must also turn in an **official school transcript** by June 14. (Some Catholic schools do not provide transcripts. We will provide you with an example of the document you need to get from your middle school if you are claiming high school credit for courses such as Algebra I or Spanish I.)

In general, you may not take summer classes for advancement. However, if you do not have credit for Algebra I, make a note below if you would like to take Algebra I over the summer this Jun, and you will be contacted by the office if this is a possibility.

Academic Records Required for Incoming TAG Students

Due: June 14, 2018

Current DISD students:

- Do not request a transcript; DallasISD will send records automatically.
- Please send us a copy of the final report card by email (hmarberry@dallasisd.org), or by dropping it off to the main office, or by fax (972-925-6018).

Students from public schools other than DISD including accredited charter schools (Texas)

- Have your school send us an official transcript. You may use the 'Request for Student Records Form'
- Send us a copy of the final report card by email.
- Send us STAAR EOC documentation for any STAAR-EOC test that the student has already taken. For incoming 9th graders, this is usually Algebra I STAAR EOC. 10th and 11th grade students may have English I, English II, and/or Biology STAAR EOC documentation.

All of this information can be sent to us by email (hmarberry@dallasisd.org), dropping it off at the main office, or by fax (972-925-6018).

Students from private schools

- Have your school send us an official transcript. You may use the 'Request for Student Records Form'
- Send us a copy of the final report card by email.
- If your school does not use official transcripts, please contact Ms. Marberry for a template the school must use so that we can give your student credit for high school courses taken in middle school.

Note: In order for us to give credit for Algebra I, the course needs to be called Algebra I (not Math 8, or Math 8 honors, Pre-Algebra, etc. This is not Algebra I)

Note: In order for us to give credit for foreign language, the course must be designated as a high school course (1.0 credit earned). We cannot transcribe Spanish 8, MS French, German, etc. it has to be Spanish I, German I, French I, etc.).
